INTERCOM 2009 is open to those proposals in two ways: Presentation and Ideas market. **To participate** in either one of them, follow these outlines:

Presentation:

- Present a summary of your own in no more than 300 words, along with your contact information before the 17th of July of the present year and send it to: papers@musa.org.mx
- Once we have confirmed you as a speaker by electronic mail, prepare the presentation with a time limit of 20 minutes. This should include a rigorous criticism of a theme related to the principal aspect of the conference.

Ideas Market:

- Present a summary of your own in no more than 300 words, along with your contact information and category of speaker before the 17th of July of the present year, and send it to papers@musa.org.mx
- Once confirmed, prepare a presentation that does not last over 7 minutes (including audio-visual material, slides, etc.) The object of each of these themes is to share a novel and practical idea (or project) with the rest of the community, without it having to be an exhaustive investigation. The success of this presentation lies in its brevity and clarity.
- The idea or central project should be of interest because of the novelty of the results and should also be applicable and transferable to other contexts.
